Three wholesome meals and all snacks are included daily. Before your child starts with us, we will discuss any specific dietary preferences and requirements, including any allergies or intolerances.

Settling In

Helping to support a gentle and smooth transition to nursery life.

Our free of charge, tailored, settling in sessions, usually last up to 2 hours and start 4 weeks before your child's first day.

We are committed to working closely with parents, each child will have opportunity to experience a variety of play, mealtime, nap times and most importantly begin to build wonderful bonds with the children and adults in their room.



Clothing

Not your child's best clothes please!

At LUV nurseries we encourage independence at mealtimes and embrace a wide variety of messy and creative play experiences, which can result in clothing getting wet or dirty. We always use water-based children's paints and encourage the use of aprons, but these don't always wash out very easily.

Please remember to clearly label all items of clothing with your child's name, there is no need for expensive name labels, a sharpie pen on the label works perfectly. Each child has their own peg, and we recommend using a pump bag with a good range of spare clothes, so we can keep them comfortable throughout the day, especially when toileting.

We have an amazing outdoor space which is hugely popular with the children and come rain or shine. We have a good supply of waterproofs at nursery but ask each child to have daily access to their own wellies and seasonal clothing.

Out & About

We are always keen to for the children to have first-hand experiences that extend their learning in the wider community.

We enjoy taking small groups on local walks, to investigate in the woodlands and to the local shops. These valuable experiences offer an abundance of learning opportunities and give the children great joy.



Parent Partnership

Close communication is essential.

From day one you will find our team warm, caring and they are committed to building respectful trusting relationships with every family. Ensuring a constant open dialogue is maintained to keep you updated with your child's day, learning and development.

We operate an open-door policy and stress that nothing is too small to talk about.



Communication



Close communication is essential and here at LUV nurseries, we use personalised daily handovers and a secure, free communication app.

This is a great way to record and share wonderful photos and details of your child's key moments alongside sharing information on your child's daily activities such as mealtimes and nappy changes etc.

Only you, the nursery, and any invited family members you invite can see your child's profile. You can view and comment on your child's profile and add to your child's learning journal by sharing any activities or special moments outside of nursery too.



Drop Off & Collection

You will be greeted by a staff member at both drop off and collection, aiding strong communication and partnerships. We have a strict collection policy, whereby a personalised password system is in place to ensure safe collection of every child.



Nursery Fees & Funding



We try to keep things simple and transparent when it comes to nursery fees. Fees are fully inclusive of all freshly prepared meals, snacks, nappies, wipes, sudocrem and sun cream.

Opening for 51 weeks of the year, our fees are divided into 12 equal payments and are due by the 1st of the month for the month ahead. Payments can be made via standing order, BACS transfer or childcare vouchers.

If your child is aged 9 months to 4 years you may be entitled to government funding. To find out more information please visit our website or speak to our nursery manager.



Policies & Procedures

All our nursery policies and procedures are available at all times in the main parent reception area.

Please do not hesitate to contact the nursery manager if you have any questions.

Sun Protection

We provide child friendly sun cream but will need your permission for its application. This can be done by ensuring the relevant permissions are kept up to date.

There are shaded areas in each garden but strongly advise each child to have their own sun hat at nursery.

Medication

All medication requires you to complete the relevant nursery permission form before it can be administered.

We will only administer medication prescribed by a professional with the acceptance of liquid paracetamol and antihistamine. If your child has been prescribed a new medicine, they must have had a full 24 hour dosage before returning to nursery.

Sickness



To reduce the risk of cross-infection, if your child is unwell, they must not attend nursery. Please note, children experience sickness or diarrhoea, must wait 48 hours until symptoms have passed before returning to nursery.

We cannot allow children into nursery if they have contracted a contagious illness such as chicken pox, respiratory infections, measles, impetigo, scarlet fever etc. We follow the best practice exclusion periods set out by government guidance. Please talk to the nursery manager if you need any further information.

If your child becomes unwell whilst at nursery, we will call you, or if we can't reach you, we will contact your emergency contact, to collect your child. Your child is always our main priority, and we will keep them as comfortable as possible until collected.



The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

At LUV Nurseries one of our fundamentals is that we love, cherish and inspire every child, supporting them to make excellent progress and reach their full potential.

We use the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) to underpin our curriculum and observe, plan and access to tailor each child's learning to their own specific needs. Our enabling environments provide exciting spaces and resources to facilitate play and extend children's learning.

The EYFS starts from birth and continues until the end of each child's Reception Year, at the age of 5.

Communication & Language

Involves providing children with a language rich environment to support their listening and attention, understanding, and speaking skills. Helping children to: build strong relationships, increase their vocabulary and conversational skills, improve social intelligence, grow in confidence and self-esteem. Communication and language is one of the main building blocks for all other areas of the EYFS.

Physical Development

Involves giving children opportunities to enjoy being active and interactive through, developing children's movement, handling of objects, understanding their own body and health and self-care. Aiding the development of children's: muscle and bone strength, spatial awareness, coordination and helping to build life-long healthy habits.



Personal & Social Development

Involves providing children with secure, warm and nurturing relationships where they are able to build strong connections with adults and peers to develop an understanding of their own feelings and those of others. Supporting social skills encourages children to grow in confidence, make friends, regulate their emotions, overcome challenges and develop a positive sense of self.

Literacy

Involves encouraging children to enjoy the process of early mark making and to develop a love of stories, books, and writing. Helping to develop early phonetical awareness and understanding to support reading and writing development.

Mathematics

Involves giving children the opportunity to develop their knowledge and skills in relation to number, numerical understanding, problem solving, patterns, shape, space and measure. Providing a playful approach to develop a secure base of knowledge and vocabulary from which future mathematical discovery is built.

Understanding the World

Involves investigating and exploring the natural world around them. Children learn to make sense of the physical world and their community and enjoy deepening their understanding about the environment, people, places and technology.

Expressive Arts & Design

Involves developing a child's imagination, creativity and ability to play and to experiment with a wide range of different media and materials. Encouraging the development of children's artistic and cultural awareness, self-expression, vocabulary, confidence and self-esteem.



Characteristics of Effective Learning

The Characteristics of effective Learning are all about how children learn and are interconnected through all areas of learning, underpinning all our EYFS environments.

♥ Playing and Exploring

This involves children investigating, finding out and experiencing things, using what they already know and be willing to 'have a go'.

♥ Active Learning

This involves children concentrating and to keep trying if they encounter challenges and enjoy achievements.

♥ Creative and Critical Thinking

This involves the children developing their own ideas, developing strategies, making links, and choosing their own way to do things.



Special Educational Needs

Children and families with special educational needs will be supported by our fully trained SENDCo.

Together a personalised learning plan will be put into place to secure the very best support and outcomes, ensuring all children requiring a little help continue to thrive and make excellent progress.



Key Person System

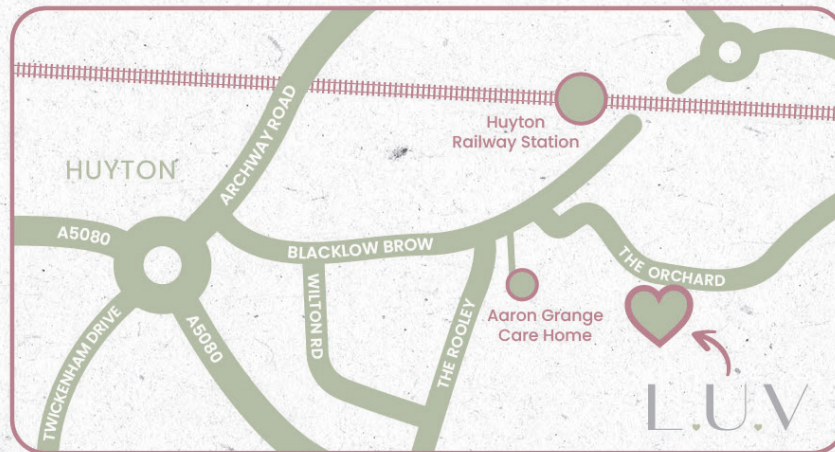
